Mix Tape Weekly CHALLENGE :

- **Make a plan as a group and as individuals to take the time to meet the needs of the hurting (children, senior citizens, handicapped, mentally challenged, unemployed, dying, grieving)– figure out how God can use you – what role can you play in Christ’s healing of others? Choose who you will seek to help then do these three things:**
 - Look into their eyes
 - Don’t look away – get on their level – help them recognize that they are people loved by God and that you care about them.
 - Pray for them by faith in the name of Jesus Christ
 - Pray for specific healing (spiritual and physical) with them and on your own.
 - Extend your hand
- **Help – get active – DO SOMETHING!**

Mission Groups are groups created by you, meeting needs that you see.

The idea is to get together with other believers and make a decision to be present and pray. Some examples of groups already being discussed include: neighborhood Bible studies, supporting local elementary schools, volunteering with youth sports, helping at the local food pantry, etc.

How do you form a mission group?

- See a need.
- Commit to being present and prayerful.
- Rally people to help.
- Let the church office know what you’re doing so we can help.

Benefits of a Mission Group:

- * Make an impact on our community.
- * Partner with others churches, Christians, and/or community organizations.
- * Build relations centered on common interests and experiences.
- * Have fun serving and meeting people and needs.

Once your group has its mission we (the church) will support, pray for and provide additional resources as needed. We can’t wait to see what God will do as we strive to reach our city.
